DECORATIONS**

The Shoalhaven Business Chamber, Nowra CBD Committee and Shoalhaven City Council have been working diligently on the Christmas decorations. In the week ahead Council staff will be up on building awnings erecting the Christmas trees.

Nowra Primary School and Nowra Anglican College Junior School have joined in and decorated over 400 Christmas stars & baubles that will be hung along the lattice work in Junction Street. This year's decorations have been a combined community effort. Hopefully they won't be vandalised.

A few weeks prior to Christmas 50 banners will be installed between the bridge and Worrigeer Street on the Princes Highway which will add colour to the highway and project a welcoming atmosphere to travellers and visitors.

CAMERAS**

Approximately 10 CCTV Cameras have been installed and are operational in Junction Street. There are more to be installed and hopefully will be in place prior to Christmas.

The Installation of the CCTV cameras has been a joint effort between the property owners and the Shoalhaven City Council. The CCTV cameras were funded through a \$150,000.00 Grant from the Attorney General's Office.

The Crime Prevention Van project is set to be launched with the van ordered and due to arrive in December.

The Crime Prevention Van is designed to address the concerns raised by a number of CBD business owners and investors by providing daily tasking and a visible law enforcement presence.

The Van is to have multiple functions which will include the reduction of incidents in identified hotspots, helping build community confidence, reducing levels of perceived and actual crime, addressing various crime categories, and providing reassurance policing.
